## HI, WE'RE MoHA.

We create **opportunities** for artists and musicians in Austin to pursue their work and **nurture their creativity**.

We are a **work space, venue, and community** for artists that prioritizes affordability, inclusivity and access. MoHA's vision is for an **empowered, resilient creative community** where each member has the resources they need to **thrive**.

We are on a mission to retain **unique, creative talent** in Austin and make space for artists to build community, sustain their careers, take risks, share their work, and **grow**.

## HERE'S HOW WE DO IT:

**SUPPORT FOR ARTISTS:** Since 2012, we have provided free studio space, paid residencies and fellowships, fiscal sponsorships, an equipment library, and other direct-benefit opportunities to thousands of local artists and musicians.

Our work has been critical in preventing the displacement of low-income and marginalized artists and creative professionals in Central Texas. We've helped 140 first-time applicants receive \$1.4 million in grant funding, and we've provided direct funding to 2,500 artists through residencies and fellowships.

**PUBLIC ACCESS:** We provide free or low-cost access to performances and exhibits to the public, presenting the work of more than 5,500 artists and musicians. 75% of this programming is free or less than \$5.

**SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITY:** We are a vibrant community space, a hub for artists and creative professionals. Our regular meet-ups and events build connections and encourage collaboration. Access to peers and mentors supports artistic development and strengthens our creative community.

Our home has been at 3600 Lyons Road in East Austin from day one. In 2012, it was inexpensive and ignored by developers, and we could exist solely on grants and program revenue. **In 2024, MoHA faces the same economic pressures that threaten the artists we support, and we need your help.**

## YOUR GENEROSITY WILL:

- GIVE** → artists who are low-income the time and space to work.
- UNDERWRITE** → public events, workshops, and exhibitions of art, music, and theater.
- GENERATE** → ideas and creativity that will ripple through our entire community.
- FIGHT** → back against the forces of gentrification that are driving out our community's artists and creative professionals.
- KEEP** → Austin Weird. (For real.)

- \$2,500** will support one 3-week online artist residency
- \$5,000** will support one month of live performance or exhibition
- \$10,000** will help subsidize our full calendar year of programming
- \$25,000** will support our annual holiday celebration
